Safety & Security Updates - Morris Rothfeldt, Executive Director for Support Services - reported that each campus now has a designated building School Safety Coordinator. These are not school resource officers. These are the point of contact for each building. These coordinators will be meeting March 1st to discuss roles and responsibilities as well as additional safety and security training. Mr. Rothfeldt also reported that the State earmarked \$50 million for districts across the state for school safety. Mr. Rothfeldt and his committee are working on a grant proposal for these funds and these funds will go towards security enhancements district-wide.

School Health Programs – Kelly Spencer, Health & Wellness Coordinator reported that administrators are working on the School Health Index. This is the evaluation of health programs in each building for SY 22-23. Administrators may be asking committee members to assist with this evaluation.
