

Act 1039

DYSLEXIA SCREENING AND INTERVENTION

Act 1039 of 2017 requires the following:

Before July 15th, a district shall report on the website or in writing to the parents of each student the following information: the dyslexia intervention programs used during the previous school year, the number of students who received dyslexia intervention, and the total number of students identified with dyslexia.

During the 2023-2024 school year, Cabot Public Schools assessed 174 students to determine if they exhibited characteristics of dyslexia. Currently, 483 students in the Cabot Public School District have either been diagnosed with dyslexia or have been identified as exhibiting characteristics of dyslexia.

During the 2023-2024 school year, 313 students received dyslexia intervention by the Cabot School District. The district utilizes Take Flight from the Scottish Rite for Children for dyslexia intervention in grades K-4 and the Sonday System from Winsor Learning for students in grades 5-12.
