\*This list is not all-inclusive. If you are observing these symptoms, or any other symptoms that are severe or concerning, please contact your medical provider.

In accordance with CDC and ADH guidelines, your child will be able to return to school after meeting the following conditions:

- A minimum of 5 days have passed since symptoms appeared and/or positive Covid result (if no symptoms were present);
- AND fever free for 24 hours without the aid of fever-reducing medication;
- AND all other symptoms have improved.

## <u>OR</u>

Negative COVID-19 test results are received and fever-free for 24 hours without the aid of fever-reducing medication.
(Rapid antigen test results will <u>not</u> be accepted).
