The board voted to approve the resolution to sell the physical structure at 710 North Lincoln Street, with the lot remaining the property of the District, for a minimum price of \$1,000 and removing this structure from Cabot inventory. This resolution also grants Dr. Tony Thurman, superintendent; Michael Byrd, deputy superintendent; or their designee to represent and sign on behalf of the District on any and all documents to effect the sale of this structure. The board voted to approve the resolution to purchase the property at 12 Lillie Street for the amount of \$200,000 plus closing costs and fees on the condition that the appraisal values the property at \$200,000 or more, and authorizing Dr. Thurman, Michael Byrd, or their designee to represent and sign on behalf of the Cabot School District all document necessary for the purchase.
