## MINUTES OF THE JULY 15, 2024 BOARD OF EDUCATION CABOT SCHOOL BOARD

Board President Joe Trusty called the meeting to order at 6:06 p.m. Those in attendance were school board members Pam Clem, Sarah Owen, Corey Williams, James Hertzog, Kevin Tipton, and Marvin Jones. Also, in attendance were Dr. Tony Thurman, Michael Byrd, directors, and community members.

The Pledge of Allegiance and moment of silence were led by Board President Joe Trusty.

#### **CONSENT AGENDA**

Minutes from the regular June 18 meeting were approved as presented. June financials were approved as presented.

Motion by Corey Williams, second by James Hertzog; passed 7-0.

#### **CURRICULUM REPORT**

**Student Data Report** – Stacy Allen and Alana Graham provided a report on summer programs. The summer reading program served 150 incoming 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade students and was held at Northside Elementary. Thirty junior high students participated in a two-week summer school to help refine their literacy and math skills. A credit recovery program was offered at the high school level and 59 students participated. Many high school students also participated in accelerated course offerings in PE, health, professional communication, and computer science.

#### SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

**2023-2024 Year End Financial Report** – Dr. Thurman reviewed the 2023-2024 year-end financial report.

**Legal Transfer Approvals** – Dr. Thurman reported that 5 outgoing legal transfers were approved and 21 incoming legal transfers were approved.

**Buildings and Grounds Report** – Michael Byrd reported that the steel structure of the practice pavilion is in place and the turf should be installed in mid-August. Plumbing is 70% complete at Pre-K North and the saferoom walls are going up. The roundabouts by Pre-K South are going well and will be open before school begins. The Child Development Center is on track and should be completed in the next few days. The drawings for the special programs addition to CAO are at the state for approval. The remainder of the technology renovation should be complete this week. A fence will be installed between the playground and the bus circle at Northside Elementary.

#### SUPERINTENDENT PRE-ACTION REPORTS

**2025 School Board Election** – Dr. Thurman read the resolution for the Cabot School Board to hold the 2025 school board election in the spring election cycle.

**2024-2025 School Improvement Plans** - Dr. Duerkop presented the 2024-2025 school improvement plans that have to be posted on the website by August 1.

**Sale of Property – 404 N. 2<sup>nd</sup> Street** – Dr. Thurman read the resolution to accept the bid and approve the sale of the property located at 404 N. 2<sup>nd</sup> Street.

**Items to Sell or Dispose of — Transportation** — Dr. Thurman read the resolution to allow the sell or disposal of several vehicles from the transportation department and remove these items from the district's inventory.

**Building Fund Transfer** – Dr. Thurman read the resolution authorizing the district to transfer \$1,000,000 from the operating fund to the building fund for the 2023-2024 school year.

The board voted to approve the resolution to hold the 2025 school board elections during the primary in the spring.

The board voted to approve the 2024-2025 school improvement plans as presented. Motion by Corey Williams, second by James Hertzog; passed 7-0.

The board voted to approve the bid of \$425,200 from The CAM Group, Inc., and to authorize Dr. Tony Thurman or his designee to represent and sign on behalf of the school district any and all documents necessary to affect the sale of this property. Board member Corey Williams left the room for the vote.

The board voted to approve the resolution to sell or dispose of vehicles no longer used by the transportation department as presented.

Motion by Corey Williams, second by Marvin Jones; passed 7-0

The board voted to approve the resolution to transfer \$1,000,000 from the operating fund to the building fund for the 2023-2024 school year.

Motion by James Hertzog, second by Pam Clem; passed 7-0.
